



## PUNJABI EDUCATION TRUST MALAYSIA CHIEF INSPECTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT 2018

Gurfateh Ji. With the Grace of the Almighty, the PETM inspectors were able to visit almost all the PECs nationwide, and provide constructive feedback to further improve the administration and the teaching of the Punjabi Language.

The Board of Inspectors had a dialogue session on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2018 to share their observation and concerns about their visits to centres in 2017, and reflect upon their roles. During this session, the inspectors highlighted the strengths and grey areas in PECs and how they could best serve and contribute towards the smooth and successful implementation of the Punjabi Language programme.

For 2018, seventeen inspectors were appointed by PETM. Besides inspection of the administration and teacher observation, the inspectors are required to take on an additional role as a mentor by providing constructive feedback and advice on how best to improve the efficient running of the centres.

The Board of Inspectors also gives feedback to PETM to help them plan teacher development courses based on actual and urgent needs of teachers. They also follow-up on the input given by PETM during these courses, which are organised from time to time. In 2017, the teacher training focussed on enhancing verbal communication among the students. Themed “An Innovative Approach To Effective Oral Communication”, the course content geared towards applying innovative approaches to help students communicate effectively. The inspectors play an important role to check if teachers put into practice what they have learnt during these courses, and provide further advice and assistance to administrators and teachers, if required.

The school inspectors have diligently executed the duties entrusted to them, and worked hand-in-hand with the PETM Board, to provide constructive check and balance in the implementation of the Punjabi Language programme nationwide.

On behalf of all the school inspectors, I thank the PETM Board for entrusting us to execute this SEWA and all the PECs for their cooperation in helping us carry out our duties.
